United Airlines Announces First-Ever Nonstop Service Between Nuuk and New York/Newark

United will be the first and only U.S. airline to offer direct flights between Greenland and the United States

New route is part of United's largest international expansion in its history

NUUK, 10 October 2024 - United Airlines today announced a new twice weekly nonstop seasonal service between Nuuk Airport and its hub at New York/Newark, starting 15 June 2025 (subject to government approval). United will be the first and only U.S. airline to offer direct flights between Greenland and the U.S.

"We are excited to announce our first-ever nonstop service between Greenland and the U.S.," said Marcel Fuchs, Managing Director International Sales, United Airlines "For summer 2025, travellers from Greenland will for the first time benefit from a direct service from Nuuk Airport to the United States, as well as the possibility to connect seamlessly via our New York/Newark hub to 89 destinations across the Americas, whilst U.S. travellers will now be able to fly nonstop in just over four hours to the northernmost capital in the world, providing a gateway to world-class hiking and fascinating wildlife under the summer's midnight sun."

"Greenland Airports is proud to welcome United Airlines to Nuuk," said Jens R. Lauridsen, CEO of Greenland Airports. "We look forward to visitors from all across North America being able to enjoy Greenland's incredible natural wonders, rich culture and history, and exciting adventures. United's service highlights the significant investment being made in not just the country's new airports, but also throughout the travel and tourism industries around the country. We are excited about more people experiencing Greenland through our partnership with United Airlines."

The new route from Nuuk to New York/Newark is part of United's largest international expansion in its history, adding 11 new flights and eight new destinations* for customers next summer. Starting in May 2025, United will launch five new flights from its hub in New York/Newark to destinations no other U.S. airline serves, including Palermo, Italy; Bilbao, Spain; and Madeira Island and Faro, Portugal. The airline is also adding three new routes from Washington D.C./Dulles, including its first-ever flight to Dakar, Senegal operating year-round and new seasonal flights to Nice, France and Venice, Italy.

United is also adding new flights from Tokyo-Narita to Kaohsiung, Taiwan; Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia; and Koror, Palau - destinations no other U.S. airline serves. These new flights will seamlessly connect to United's transpacific services operated at Tokyo-Narita to five hub locations in the continental United States.

Many of the new flights will be available for sale on United.com and on the United app in the coming weeks.

United is the largest airline in the world, as measured by available seat miles, and flies to more international destinations than any other U.S. carrier. In total, next summer United will offer 800 daily flights to and from 147 international destinations – including 40 that no other U.S. airline serves.

United's service nonstop service from Nuuk to New York/Newark will be operated with Boeing 737 MAX 8 aircraft, featuring 16 United Premium PlusSM, 54 Economy PlusSM and 96 economy seats.

<u>United Premium Plus</u> features a spacious seat with more legroom, elbow room and recline than a standard Economy Plus or economy seat, as well as an amenity kit, Saks Fifth Avenue blanket and plush pillow.

United Economy Plus offers added legroom and increased personal space. Located near the front of the economy cabin, the seats give the added benefit of a swifter exit from the plane on arrival. Economy Plus seating is available on all trans-Atlantic flights.

United economy offers complimentary food, soft drinks, juices, beer and wine, tea, coffee and inflight entertainment. On most aircraft, seats feature an adjustable headrest and a personal on-demand entertainment system.

United in New York/Newark

Located just 23 kilometres from Manhattan, Newark Liberty International Airport offers the fastest surface transfer journeys to many parts of the city, including the AirTrain service to New York Penn Station in midtown Manhattan, with a journey time of less than 30 minutes.

During the summer season 2025, United plans to serve over 150 destinations in 45 countries from Newark. United's Newark hub is its largest transatlantic gateway, with service planned to 38 destinations in Europe, India, Africa and the Middle East.
